

## The Ambassador

**The Ambassador** is a Kna'ash from the planet Luk'Cha. The Kna'ash have a blue and scaly body. Their nose is made of two nostrils and they two long appendixes that fall on either side of their heads instead of hair. In Luk'Cha tradition, she wears long robes and a hood over her head.
